No Commission Based Tours - Most regular tours – either openly or indirectly – take tour groups to preferred locations. This might include “jade” factory, silk workshops, art galleries etc. The Advance tour DOES NOT include any of these visits with the pressure to purchase.

Flexibility while the tour program will be well developed there does remain some flexibility in our program. Not being linked to local tour company gives this program greater flexibility in areas such as coach arrangements, meal stops and evening entertainment.

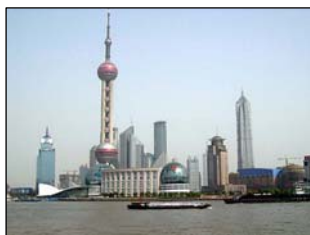
